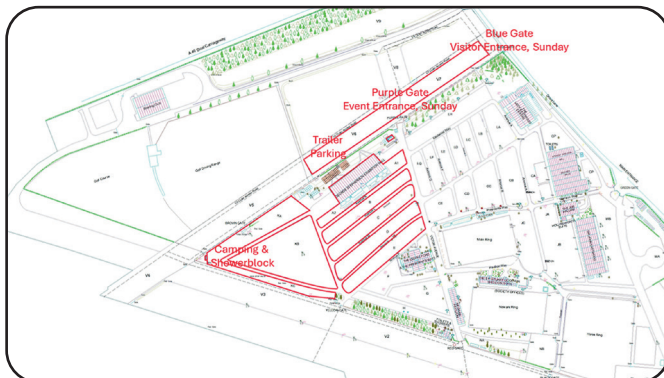

Cars of Distinction

Thanks to amazing generosity from supporters of our Club we have two, world renowned Escorts on display for visitors to admire.

On display is one very special car, kindly loaned to us by Ford Heritage Collection. The car now bearing the reg H1 FEV started its rallying career in 1993 in the 25 year anniversary re-run of the 1968 London to Sydney rally, build by Webster and Lancaster, entered by FMC with Gavin Green (Car Magazine) as driver. It was then prepared by Historic Motor Sport for the 25 year anniversary re run of the 1970 London to Mexico rally with Hannu Mikkola driving again and he of course won it, it was for this event that it got its current reg which is a reference to the original 1970 winning car (FEV 1H).



Cars of Distinction

From the personal car collection of Malcolm Wilson OBE, founder of M-Sport, based at Cockermouth, is the very special Mk2 Escort RS2000.

This is a 1976 Ford Escort RS 2000 which was a bespoke and unique build for Henry Ford II when he toured Europe and the UK in the 1970s. It has a unique leather interior and is in a one-off colour to the Ford Escort range, but it's also an automatic which was never made for the Ford Escort RS2000 model. This special car has done just 44,000 miles.

To own the RS2000 that was the personal car of Henry Ford II while he was living in the UK is a case of owning living history.

Henry Ford II, sometimes known as “Hank the Deuce”, was the eldest son of Edsel Ford I and the eldest grandson of Henry Ford. Head of Ford Motor Company for 34 years (1945-79), he is generally credited with reviving the firm's fortunes.



Cars Of Distinction

James Lepley Motorsport

Ford Sierra RS Cosworth -
JZ-27-20

This is an ex-works Group A rally car, driven by Joaquim Santos and co-driven by the team owner, Miguel Oliveira. The car was run by Diabolique motorsport, a team revered within Portugal and Spain. Santos and Oliveira won several rallies across the Portuguese and European championship, and took the Group A Portuguese title in 1988.

This car was mechanically restored in 2021, but kept completely original including the paintwork and stickers. Joaquim Santos and several Diabolique team members were reunited with the car at Goodwood Festival of Speed in 2023.

Ford Motorsport Escort
Cosworth - N870 GNO

The car was built for Ford Motorsport by Gordon Spooner Engineering for Colin McRae as a recce car for the World Rally Championship events during his time with Ford Motorsport/ M-Sport. The car was then driven by his father Jimmy Mcrae when he was acting as weather crew for Colin during the rallies. The car is completely unspoilt and is completely original.

Since 1994 Lincs & Notts Air Ambulance has flown >31,000 potential lifesaving missions providing pre-hospital emergency care.

The crew attend the most serious of incidents and carry out life-saving advanced procedures on scene before transferring patients to the hospital.

The team of doctors and paramedics carry life-saving equipment on board the helicopter which means they take an emergency department directly to the scene of some of the most serious

incidents in Lincolnshire & Nottinghamshire. The crews work closely with the ambulance service, first responders, Police, Fire & Rescue and other emergency services such as HM Coastguard.



Introducing our Charity Partner

Every day, 24 hours, 365 days per year, LNAA's critical care teams respond to an average of 4 life-threatening emergencies across 3,500 square miles. But with only one helicopter, we cannot always reach everyone who needs us, and that can mean missed missions when time matters most.

Demand for our service has grown by 135% in five years. A second helicopter will help us reach more patients faster, reduce missed callouts, and give more people the best possible chance of survival.

We have already secured pledges and donations for most of the £7m needed and have booked our place on the production line.

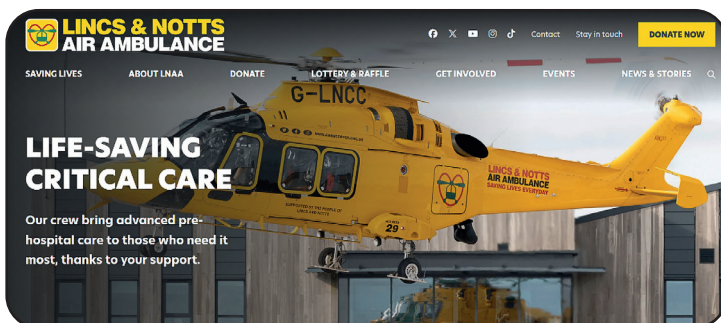
The mission ahead is now to raise £500,000 needed to get the second helicopter in the air by late-summer 2027.

We will then have two air ambulances that can get to any corner of Lincolnshire and Nottinghamshire in under 20 minutes.

Someone who needs no introduction. Drummer, motoring journalist, TV Presenter and mechanic. Probably best known for his leading role in the popular TV series Car SOS, Fuzz Townshend completed his apprenticeship with the West Midlands Passenger Transport Executive.

He recorded two sessions with John Peel on Radio 1 and released his first single which charted in the NME Indie Charts.

His first journalism role was with Practical Classics magazine where he became Technical Editor until 2011. Later, he started a new classic car restoration business, Westgate Classics.

In 2016 he left Westgate to set up To-Ta Classics Ltd which later changed to SOS Workshop Ltd. The business featured as the shows location and in 2018 Car SOS won the National Reality TV Award for “Most Inspirational Show”

In Focus - Ford Heritage

Ford of Britain recently announced the launch of the brand-new Heritage and Innovation Centre.

Previously stored in Dagenham, the Ford of Britain collection - which contains a host of historically significant vintage vehicles - has now been moved to the brand-new Heritage and Innovation Centre which is located at the Daventry Parts Distribution Centre site. The collection contains a wide array of historically important Blue Oval vehicles, including cars and commercial models, as well as important milestone vehicles and race cars.

In total, the collection consists of around 120 vehicles, and is currently used for promotional and media purposes. A group of dedicated Heritage technicians and volunteers, many retired from within the Ford organisation, look after this important collection.

"The move to the new location will allow for greater access to this very special collection, as well as an opportunity to show our customers how Ford has played a major role in personal and business transportation within the UK over the past 100 years, from Model T to now Model E," said Len Keen, who runs the new centre.





Operating a flourishing global motorsport business, M-Sport has quickly become an industry leader with state-of-the-art facilities and winning performances around the globe.

Chosen to mastermind Ford's assault on the FIA World Rally Championship, the Cumbrian-based team have secured seven FIA World Rally Championships, 64 victories, 272 podiums and 301 consecutive points finishes to date - making them one of the sport's most successful outfits.

In its mission to be a world leader in rallying, M-Sport also operates a thriving customer support business for private teams. Assisting Ford drivers with motorsport programmes around the world and establishing a true Ladder of Opportunity, they are the only manufacturer to offer a car across all levels of the FIA Rally Pyramid and the biggest manufacturer of Ford racing vehicles in the world.

However, M-Sport is not limited to the World Rally Championship (WRC) but also participates in a range of other rallying competitions, including the Dakar Rally, first competed in 2024, the British Rally Championship, and the European Rally Championship.



But it's not just in rallying that M-Sport excels. In 2013 the company caught the eye of Bentley Motors and embarked on a new venture on the racetrack - selected to spearhead the design and development of the luxury manufacturer's Continental GT3. Completing the first car in just six months, the Continental GT3 went on to secure considerable success and became the car of choice for a number of works-supported teams around the globe.

In 2018, M-Sport also entered the world of electric motorsport as Jaguar's technical partner in the I PACE eTROPHY. Running alongside the FIA Formula E Championship, the zero-emission series completed two seasons and was M-Sport's first step into sustainable motorsport.

Additionally, M-Sport supplies engines for the TOCA British Touring Car Championship and the Ford Mustang GT3 for prestigious events like the 24 Hours of Le Mans and 24 Hours of Daytona.

As well as its main Dovenby Hall operations on the edge of the UNESCO English Lake District National Park, M Sport has expanded to include a European base with a state-of-the-art facility in Krakow, Poland - where lays responsibility for all two-wheel-drive activities.

We're the officers who genuinely love cars and genuinely hate what happens when they're driven badly. The Nottinghamshire Roads Policing Unit is a team of advanced qualified officers dedicated to keeping the county's roads safe, targeting serious offenders, supporting victims, and yes occasionally appreciating a well-maintained Ford RS at the roadside

OUR KEY PRIORITIES

Enforcement -The Fatal Four

Four behaviours cause the majority of fatal and serious collisions in the UK. Speed, drink and drug driving, seatbelts, and mobile phones. We target them relentlessly, because the statistics behind them aren't numbers they're people.

THE FATAL FOUR – IN PLAIN ENGLISH

Speed – Inappropriate speed features in around a quarter of fatal collisions. It's not just about limits, it's the right speed for the road, the conditions, and the traffic around you.

Drink & Drug Driving – Impaired driving kills. Our officers use roadside drug wipe technology, and the science has never been sharper. If you're on it, we will find you and the morning after is not the safe window you think it is.

Seatbelts – Unbelted occupants are twice as likely to die in a collision. "I was only going round the corner" has never once held up. Buckle up, every single time, no exceptions.

Mobile Phones – A handheld phone at the wheel makes you four times more likely to crash. Your notifications can wait. A life cannot be restored with a quick scroll back up.

Serious Crime

Roads are how criminals move. Every stop is an opportunity, County lines, stolen vehicles, weapons, and wanted persons all get found on the roadside. Your commute is our patrol corridor.

Advanced Driving

Every RPU officer holds a national advanced driving qualification. We pursue, we intercept, we respond at speed and we do it to the highest standard in policing.

Education Over Prosecution

Not every offence needs a court date. Speed awareness and driver education courses genuinely change behaviour, and we'd rather you changed your habits than your liberty.

Vulnerability and Safeguarding

Uninsured drivers, county lines runners, missing persons, roads stops uncover vulnerability every single day. We're not just traffic cops. We're safeguarding officers on wheels.

A WORD FROM ONE CAR PERSON TO ANOTHER

Many of our officers spend their weekends at track days, detailing bays, and shows genuinely passionate about cars. Which is exactly why it matters to us when that passion becomes a danger. Modified cars, performance vehicles, and enthusiast culture are not our enemy. A well-maintained, legally modified car driven by a responsible, skilled driver is not a problem.

Nottinghamshire Road Policing Unit

What we do care about:

Tyres – 400bhp means nothing on worn rubber. Legal minimum is 1.6mm; anything approaching that in the wet is a death wish. Spend the money.

Insurance & Modifications – Declare your mods. An undisclosed turbo upgrade or suspension swap can void your entire policy. Don't win on the road and lose in the courtroom.

Noise – Straight-through exhausts at 2am through a residential area. We hear you. So does everyone else. Keep it legal, keep the hobby alive.

Lighting – Non-type-approved HID or LED conversions can dazzle oncoming drivers. Bright doesn't mean right. Stay road-legal.

Vehicle Condition – Defective brakes and worn tyres aren't just MOT failures – they're potential charges. Your car is your responsibility, every time you drive it.

FORENSIC COLLISION INVESTIGATION – THE SCIENCE BEHIND THE SCENE

When the worst happens, the truth matters. Our Roads Policing Unit works directly alongside Nottinghamshire's Forensic Collision Investigation Team – specialist officers who turn a crash scene into a precise scientific reconstruction.

Using 3D laser scanning, tachograph analysis, vehicle Event Data Recorder (black box) recovery, tyre and road surface analysis, and crash simulation software, they establish exactly what happened to the metre, the millisecond, and the mile per hour.

This isn't guesswork. It's engineering-grade collision science that supports criminal prosecutions, coroner's inquests, and critically helps us understand why collisions happen so we can prevent the next one. Every collision tells a story. Our job is to make sure that story is heard accurately, for victims, for families, and for justice.

Newark Air Museum

Located adjacent to Newark Showground. The Trustees have kindly agreed to allow National Day ticket holders to visit the museum during the day for £6.50 (upon production of an RSOC membership card or copy of ND ticket) compared to the normal adult admission charge of £12.50.

Immerse yourself in the history of aviation. Welcome to Newark Air Museum, where aviation history comes to life! Explore our impressive collection of over 80 aircraft and discover captivating exhibits that celebrate the legacy of flight and aviation heritage.



Camping

Camping is a great way to mix and enjoy the National Day weekend.

Ground fires and fire pits are not allowed anywhere on the showground.

All BBQs must be raised off the grass and only lit away from tents/ awnings. Used BBQs coals must be soaked, drained of water and disposed of in waste bins.

There are numerous water points around the Showground which are all clearly marked.

Please take care in the shower blocks as floors may be slippery and chemical toilets must only be emptied at the disposal points provided and not in the toilets.

In the event of a fire.

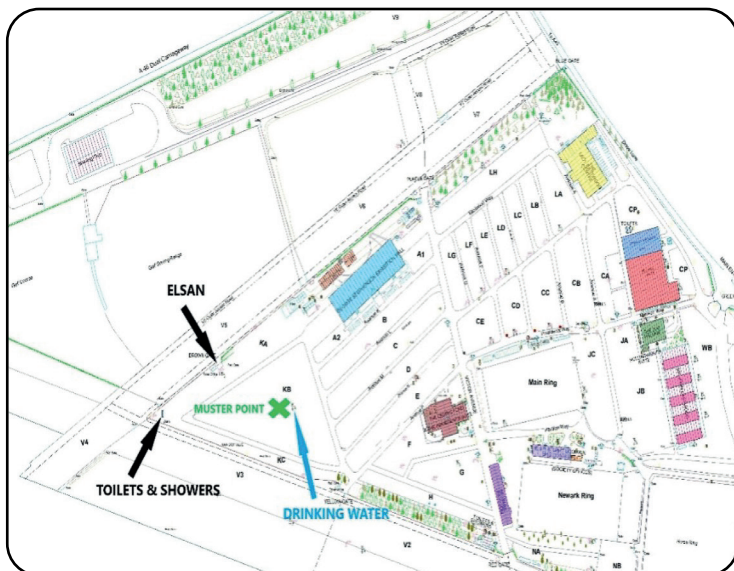
Keep calm and get everyone out as quickly as you can.
